How many times have you complained about the speed of your PC? It seems ironic that we have devices capable of processing millions of calculations each second and we still get impatient with them!

Nevertheless, there is one easy "speed-up" tip for any computer running Windows. Logic will tell us the more applications that are up and running, the more work a PC has to do. Therefore, closing unused applications will speed up any PC!

This includes those tiny icons down by the clock in the lower right-hand corner of your monitor. Each icon represents another program at work. Take a look through them to see which of them could possibly be disabled. A simple right-click on any of them will reveal a "Quit" or "Exit" option.

- 3. Native plants provide shelter and food for wildlife.

- 4. Native plants require less water than lawns. They can also reduce water runoff and flooding.
- 5. Native plants help reduce air pollution. Natural landscapes do not require mowing!
- 6. Native plants provide shelter and food for wildlife.
- 7. Native plants promote biodiversity. They can even invite butterflies and birds.
